ProKids Adopt-a-Family Program

Make the holiday season extra special by purchasing specific toys and gifts from the wish lists of children in the Hamilton County Child Protection System.

The children and families served by ProKids Adopt-a-Family program are often our 'highest need' cases due to the difference between kinship placements (with relatives and family friends) and foster care. Family and friends often accept placement of children unexpectedly and are not prepared with all the necessary items and receive significantly less support than licensed foster care providers. For example, this might be a single grandmother on a fixed income who overnight becomes a placement for her two young grandchildren. Along with holiday gifts for children, many families assisted through this program also benefit greatly from household items such as cleaning supplies and extra sheets or food items for a holiday dinner, such as ham and mashed potatoes. Adopt-a-Family provides these families with the ability to fully celebrate the holidays.

How Adopt-a-Family Works

In early November, you will be matched with a family, receive their wish list, and be connected with the ProKids CASA Manager assigned to their case. The CASA Manager can answer any questions about the family or requested items and will coordinate the most convenient time and location for drop-off. If you would like to wrap gifts, we kindly request gift bags vs. wrapping paper so our team is able to keep an internal inventory of the donations distributed.
